1. Purpose of the General Conditions of Use:

The General Conditions of Use are intended to define the rules of use of the site by the user, as well as the obligations of the DiGiPort Platform (hereinafter “Platform”).

The users agree that each time they visit the Platform, to respect the present General Conditions of Use, which are applicable to all content available on the Platform.

The Platform restricts and reserves the capability to Users of performing purchases through the Platform.

The Users can only view artworks and the profiles of Artists hosted in the Platform.

The Users can have access to Artists’ contact information and social media accounts via the Platform in order to contact the Artists for future purchases of their services.

Expenses (Internet, hardware...) incurred by the Users to access the Platform remain their responsibility.

4. Liability of the DiGiPort Platform:

The Platform cannot be held responsible for any fraud, scam, error or damage on artwork before, during or after it has been shipped to the Buyer.

The Platform is not responsible for any kind of misuse of the aforementioned information (Artists’ contact details and social media).

The Platform is not responsible for any kind of communication that occurs between Artists and Buyers, either in or out of the Platform.

The use of the Platform and its services implies acceptance of these General Conditions of Use, without however having to create an account.

The Platform allows the Users free access to the services.

The Platform is accessible free of charge by any User with an Internet connection.

We expect the Users of the Platform to respect and value the hard work of the team that developed the Platform and the Artists hosted within the Platform's contents.

5. Intellectual Property
